Task 1: Look closely at the painting "Migration Pride". What words can you find in it? Look at the ten words below and circle the words that are in the painting:






At the end of your visit, you can find out more about these words on the answer sheet that you will receive at the ticket desk.

Imagine you are going to a demonstration. What is important for you? What would you like to change? Write it on your sign and make sure to keep your message short:









Here you'll see many different kinds of art: colorful plastic chairs, curtains made of fabric, and paintings on the wall.

Task 4: Look carefully at the image "An Elephant In Front of the Window, White Pretzel".


How many elephants can you see? Check the box next to the correct number:
